Know all Men by these Presents that I John Heningar of the Township of Douglas in the County of Hants in the Province of Nova Scotia Farmer — for and in consideration of the love good will and affection which I have and do bear — towards my loving son Christian Heningar of the same place Farmer and also in consideration of the sum of Five shillings of lawful money of Nova Scotia to me in hand well and truly paid by the said Christian Heningar at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge Have given and granted and by these presents Do freely give and grant unto the said Christian Heningar his heirs — executors and administrators All the following piece or parcel of land situate in Douglas aforesaid containing by estimation Two hundred and fifteen acres more or less bounding and abutting in manner and form following that is to say Beginning where the Northern side of the Public road now cuts the eastern side line of land belonging to my brother George Heningar and running thence along said east side line North ten degrees west Four hundred and sixty seven rods unto the South west angle of land intended to be granted to my son George Heningar thence along the south line of said land and running east ten degrees North —

eighty two rods unto the Western side line
of land belonging to my brother Jacob
Heningar thence along said West side
line South ten degrees east Four —
hundred and sixty seven rods unto the
Northern side of the said public road
and thence westwardly along the said
side of the Public road unto the place
of beginning containing by estimation
Two hundred and fifteen acres more
or less To have and to hold the
aforesaid piece or parcel of land and
every part thereof to him the said
Christian Heningar his heirs and
assigns for ever In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this ninth day of September
one thousand eight hundred and forty
seven.
