

This Indenture made this seventh day of October in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety five Between George F. Mosher of Huron in the County of Colchester and Province of Nova Scotia, machinist, and John N. Dell of Kennetcook in the said County of Hants, blacksmith, trustees under a certain deed of trust, of the First Part and Addisow Hennigar of Kennetcook aforesaid, farmer, of the Second Part.

Whereas in and by a certain indenture bearing date the twentieth day of August in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine, recorded in the Office for the Registry of Deeds for the said County of Hants in Book 85 page 630 on the 26th day of September A.D. 1895, James Hennigar and others did convey to the parties hereto of the first part a certain lot piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in Kennetcook aforesaid and in the said indenture particularly described upon the several trusts in the said indenture mentioned as upon reference thereto recorded as aforesaid will more fully and at large appear.

Now This Indenture Witnesseth that the said George F. Mosher and John N. Dell, as such trustees as aforesaid, in consideration of the premises and the sum of one dollar to them in hand well and truly paid by Addisow Hennigar of Kennetcook aforesaid, farmer, at or before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed released conveyed and confirmed and by these presents Do grant bargain sell alien convey release convey and confirm unto the said Addisow Hennigar his heirs and assigns the said lot piece or parcel of land hereinbefore mentioned and which is thus described viz. All that certain lot piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in Kennetcook aforesaid in the said County of Hants and bounded and described as follows, that is to say, Beginning

on the north side of the Hemmetcook River at the south east angle
of George Hemnegar's farm lot, thence north ten degrees west
to the Highway, thence by the said Highway easterly eighty
two rods more or less to lands of Dr James Tier, & thence
south ten degrees east to the said River, ^{by the line of said land of Dr James Tier,} thence by the se-
veral courses of the River down stream westwardly to the
place of beginning containing eight acres more or less, to-
gether with all and singular the buildings ways waters
watercourses easements privileges and appurtenances to
the said land belonging and the reversions and reversions, re-
mainders rents issues and profits thereof and all the estate
right title interest claim property and demand of them the
said George J. Mosher and John N. Dill as such trustees
as aforesaid of in and to the same and every part thereof To
Have and To Hold the said lot piece or parcel of land above
described together with all and singular the privileges and
appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Addressor Hen-
negar his heirs and assigns to his and their sole use bene-
fit and behoof forever as fully and entirely as they the
said George J. Mosher and John N. Dill as such trustees
as aforesaid are entitled or empowered to convey the
same.

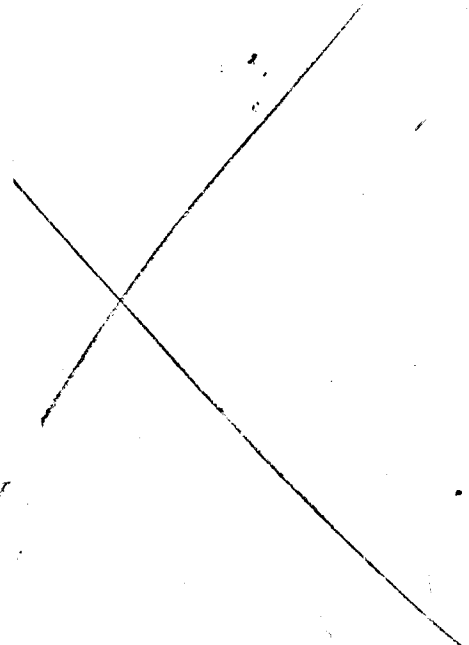
